The Meetinghouse program for **Christian Leadership Scholars** is designed to help students explore vocation. Vocation is our calling, the work or mission God wants us to prepare for and devote ourselves to. **The CLS program**, led by Dr. Roger Ward and Dr. Sheila Klopfer, is a four year program which includes educational opportunities and experiences like international travel and retreats to help students expand their horizons while listening keenly for their calling.

The freshman year begins with a celebration for CLS students during orientation and a banquet in November that is an introduction to vocation through conversation, literature, and reflection.

The sophomore year focuses on learning about vocation and reflecting on one's calling through reading, service, and travel, including a Fall Break Retreat and Spring Break Trip.

The junior year focuses on international travel and deepening the student's reflection on vocation. During this time, students may receive travel scholarships for an international trip in the areas of academic, ministry or service activity.

In the final year of the program, students will plan for continuing their vocational journey with the help of a mentor. The program concludes with a banquet celebrating accomplishments and encouraging a vocational discernment.

Since its inception in 1980, the Christian Leadership Scholarship (CLS) Program has become a prestigious and selective recognition for entering freshmen. In keeping with this tradition, the scholarship remains selective with only one out of every three applications receiving a scholarship.

Christian Leadership Scholarships are awarded to students who exemplify Christian characteristics through their actions in volunteering and serving both in the church and the community while continuing strong academic preparation in school.

A committee comprised of pastors and ministers from local churches and college personnel will select recipients for the CLS. Students will be selected on the basis of their leadership levels, Christian commitment, essay and recommending statements provided by their pastor or minister. Students may receive awards of either \$1,000 or \$2,500 per year (renewable up to four years).

 - Please give your pastor/minister adequate time to complete and return the application by February 1.
