

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION / SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

General Instructions

1. Complete all three pages of the Application for Admission and the Scholarship and Financial Assistance Questionnaire. Please type or print in dark ink.
2. Include a non-refundable \$30 application fee, payable to Georgetown College.
3. Complete the area at the top of the Application for Admission page indicating what is being sent with the application.
4. Include an official high school transcript from all high schools that you have attended. (May be mailed separately.)
5. Include an official ACT (code 1514) or SAT-I (code 1249) score, if not on your high school transcript. (May be mailed separately.)
6. Letters of recommendation or other supporting material will be considered but are not required.
7. Additional information may be requested.

Transfer Application

1. Follow general instructions above, plus the following:
2. Have official transcripts from all colleges you have attended sent to the Office of Admissions.
3. For students currently enrolled in another college at the time of application, an initial admission decision may be made; however, a final admission decision will be made when all transcripts are received (inclusive of all college credits).

Re-Admission for Former Georgetown College Students

1. Complete the Application for Admission.
2. Former Georgetown students are not required to submit the \$30 application fee.
3. If applicable, include all transcripts from colleges attended after leaving Georgetown.

Post-Baccalaureate, Transient, Special, Other

If you are applying to Georgetown College as a student in one of the following categories, you may complete this application or call the admissions office at (800) 788-9985 for a separate, shorter application:

- **Post Baccalaureate:** You have already received a Bachelor's degree, or you are seeking another Bachelor's degree.
- **Transient:** You plan to take one class and have the credit transferred to another institution.
- **Special:** You only want to take one class.
- **Other:** You want to audit a class.

Applying for Financial Assistance

1. Complete the Scholarship and Financial Assistance Questionnaire portion of the Application for Admission.
2. For scholarship students, applicants for the Fall semester must submit the Application for Admission postmarked no later than FEBRUARY 1. Spring students must submit the application no later than December 1.
3. File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Students competing for academic scholarships should complete the FAFSA by February 15. All other applicants should follow the priority deadline of March 15. Georgetown's FAFSA code is 001964.
4. All applicants for student financial assistance must submit an Application for Admission and receive notification of their admission to the college before scholarship and/or financial assistance packages can be officially offered/awarded.
