

CCSA TRAVEL SCHOLARSHIPS

Georgetown College receives \$1,500 in scholarship funds from CCSA each calendar year to assist students participating in CCSA programs. These funds are typically awarded to three to six students (\$250 to \$500 each), with approximately half going to students participating in summer programs, and half to students traveling on winter programs. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic performance and the student's ability to represent CCSA in a positive manner.

Requirements:

The scholarship applicant must:

1. Be a full-time student in good academic standing at Georgetown College.
2. Be enrolled at Georgetown College during the semester prior to travel.
3. Have an overall grade point average of 2.5.
4. Be receiving need-based financial aid.
