Internship Opportunities

Global Scholars are required to complete two internships. Internships are available with organizations across a web of global companies in the United States and abroad. Through the Graves Center for Calling and Career at Georgetown College, students will identify their interests and receive guidance in choosing appropriate internships.

Examples of seminars and events

- Yearly Worldview Briefing by a professor from University of Kentucky's Patterson School of Diplomacy and International Commerce
- Presentations by CEOs, CFOs and Presidents of global companies as well as individuals with international experience
- International art exhibits at museums and galleries
- Behind-the-scenes tours of businesses and organizations engaged in international commerce, such as Alltech, Keeneland, Kentucky Horse Park, Lexmark, Toyota Motor Manufacturing (TMMK) and UPS Worldport
- On-campus and off-campus attendance at monthly leadership development events

Global Scholars may participate in any of Georgetown College's academic programs.

2. **Student Resumé.** List ALL leadership positions held in your school and community.
3. **Reference Form.** Please give your reference adequate time to complete and return the application. Application Deadline is February 1.

Global Scholar applicants must apply for admission (separate application form), note their intent to apply for the Global Scholars Program and be admitted to Georgetown College to be considered.

Georgetown College will select up to 10 new students per year as Global Scholars. These Scholars receive a \$1,000 scholarship upon meeting program expectations and requirements. Scholarships are renewable annually.

Expectations

Scholars are expected to maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA and remain active in the Global Scholars Program. All college academic and other policies and requirements apply to Scholars. All Scholars are expected to participate in some unpaid projects as selected by the Global Scholars Program Leadership Team.

A committee of faculty advisors and college personnel will select the recipients. Scholars will be selected for interviews on the basis of their interest in international opportunities, the requested essay, leadership resumé and recommending statements from the applicant’s reference.
