## **Global Scholar Learning Option**

Georgetown College's Global Scholars use the flexibility of the liberal arts curriculum to expand their global perspective. In order to earn their acknowledgement as a Global Scholar, scholars must complete at least three projects during their academic career in three classes of their choice (with faculty approval) that reflect on their interest in international studies during their academic career as a Global Scholar. The intention is to provide an opportunity for the student to view his/her classroom work from a global perspective thus adding an international component to his/her discipline. These projects can take a variety of forms. For instance, a student could complete a paper assignment on a topic with an international focus, create a work of art that is inspired by multiculturalism, make a presentation in a speech class that focuses on some aspect of internationalization, complete a business class project on the international business practices, etc.

**Faculty members are not asked to adjust their assignments in order to accommodate the Global Option; this option should be something that fits within the normal structure of the class assignment.** In order for the project to receive credit as a Global Option, it must earn the grade of A or B.

This contract between the GLOBAL SCHOLAR, a FACULTY MEMBER overseeing the learning option project, and the GLOBAL SCHOLAR LEADERSHIP TEAM (Amy Carrington, Darryl Callahan, Sally Weisenberger), has been developed because Georgetown College and the Global Scholars Program has a high degree of interest in the student's ability to apply his/her international interest into a broad-based scholarly context. The Learning Option Project is a three-way partnership which works together for the common goal of developing productive professionals and global leaders.



## LEARNING OPTION CONTRACT FORM

The faculty member agrees to:

- 1) oversee the Learning Option Project.
- 2) submit a completed “*Evaluation of Performance*” form at the completion of the assignment to the Global Scholars office.

The Global Scholar (student) agrees to:

- 1) work under the guidance of a faculty member.
- 2) submit *Learning Option Contract* (signed by both scholar and faculty member) to Global Scholars office within one week of choosing assignment as Learning Option Project.
- 3) complete and submit *Final Reflection Essay* (form not attached) describing the project experience at the completion of the assignment to Global Scholars office.

The Leadership Team agrees to:

- 1) make student aware of Learning Option Project requirements.
- 2) provide student with guidance on Learning Option Project.
- 3) assign Global Scholars credit upon successful completion of Learning Option Project.
- 4) work with faculty member and student to make Learning Option Project a beneficial experience for all parties.
