

By 7:30 a.m. Saturday, May 11, a decision regarding the location of the ceremony will be made. Students and parents may call the Campus Safety Office at (502)863-8111, check the Commencement website (www.georgetowncollege.edu/commencement), or the check portal to find out the location of the ceremony.

In clear weather, the ceremony will be held outside on the lawn of Giddings Hall. The number of guests is not limited, and those attending may sit anywhere in the seating area other than the reserved designated sections.

NOTE: For those guests who may need to watch the ceremony inside, live streaming will be available in the Asher Science Center (#5), Room 112.

In the event of inclement weather, Commencement will be held in Davis-Reid Alumni Gymnasium (#11). Due to fire code regulations, seating in the gym is limited. Each graduate will receive four (4) complimentary tickets for admission to the gym for family and/or friends.

In case of inclement weather, in order to accommodate all our guests, we will limit the number that can be seated in the area designated for those needing special assistance to four (4) guests per party. Additional guests will be seated in the general seating area.

If inside, guests will not be admitted without a ticket. Tickets will be distributed to the graduates at Commencement practice, Friday, May 10. For those students who do not attend practice, tickets will be available at the will-call station located on the Putting Green (#6), near the Davis Reid Alumni Gymnasium (#11) beginning at 8:00 a.m. on the morning of commencement.

Additional seating (no ticket required) for viewing Commencement will be available on a first come, first served basis in John L. Hill Chapel (#18). Live video and audio for the Commencement program will be provided.

We are happy to provide a will-call station located on the Putting Green (#6), near the Davis Reid Alumni Gymnasium (#11) in case you need to leave tickets for members of your party. All tickets must be picked up by 9:45 a.m.

Graduates with a valid ID may pick up extra tickets, if available, at Campus Safety after 8:00 a.m. on the morning of Commencement.
